

Command List

Yes!

I like what you are doing and cookie(treat) is coming.

Okay, Release or All Done

You are finished working, you are free to be a dog.

Sit

Stop and sit, remain sitting until you hear your release.

Down

Stop and lie down. Remain down until you hear your release.

Stand

Stand still like a statue. Remain standing until you hear your release.

Stay

I'm leaving you here, stay here until I return and you hear your release.

Wait

Wait until I call you or give you another command.

Come

Stop what you're doing and immediately run to me. Get close enough and allow me to gently take hold of your collar, do not move until you hear your release.

Let's go

Walk with your handler on a loose leash sit when your handler stops.

Off

All four feet are touching the floor. Use this for a dog who jumps up.

Reset

Toss a cookie away from your pup, let them chase after the treat, eat it and then call them to you to work on a given behavior.

Uh Oh - What Happened?

Using this command when we have asked our dog for a behavior and they have not yet given us what we have asked of them. This command acts as a mental reset.

Why we don't use NO - We use no too much and dogs become desensitized. By using other commands like Uh oh, helps dogs discern when to keep trying for behaviors or completely stop a behavior. Try only using no in real danger situations.
