



House Rules & Guidelines for Attending Classes at Happy Acres

1. All dogs are to be leashed at ALL TIMES. Dogs must be leashed prior to exiting your vehicle. All dogs and handlers deserve a minimum of 6 feet of personal space at all times - please keep your dog away from other dogs.
2. Prong collars, choke chains, slip leads and retractable leashes will not be used while the dog is on Happy Acres Dog Training property. Proper equipment is required to participate in class.
3. Please potty dogs at home before coming to class. There is a grass area out the front door of the training center for dogs to use. Do not use the lawns west of the driveway to potty your dogs. All feces must be scooped immediately.
4. Please wait outside until the previous class is out of the building. Giving the class ahead of you room to get out the door and get to their cars is greatly appreciated.
5. Happy Acres Dog Training is a Smoke Free facility. Smoking is not tolerated on this property.
6. Junior handlers are encouraged to participate in class. An adult must accompany junior handlers (any handler under age 18) during class. DO NOT drop off children with a dog for class; they will not be permitted to participate without an adult present. Also, please use common sense; large or powerful dogs should be matched with a handler who is physically capable of controlling the dog.
7. Do not approach another dog and do not allow your dog to approach another dog without explicit permission from the handler. This is for the safety of all dogs and all handlers and their families who attend classes here at the center.
8. Please keep your dog quiet to the best of your ability.
9. DO NOT leave additional dogs in the car during class. Only dogs attending class should accompany you. If there are extenuating circumstances, please discuss them with your instructor ahead of arrival.
